Questions and Answers

Question No. 1: Interns – Interpreter Interns are typically not paid and do not replace qualified interpreters. Is HCC suggesting using interns in place of certified interpreters? **HCC Response:** No.

Question No. 2: Am I required to submit a proposal for both Sign Language Interpretive Services and C.A.R.T. Services? May I submit a proposal for C.A.R.T. Services only? **HCC Response:** No, you are not required to submit a proposal for both Sign Language Interpretive Services and C.A.R.T. Services. Yes, you may submit a proposal for C.A.R.T. Services only.

Question No. 3: Will HCC consider remote C.A.R.T. Services as an alternative to onsite C.A.R.T. Services?

HCC Response: No. However, you may submit this as a supplement to your proposal for HCC consideration.
